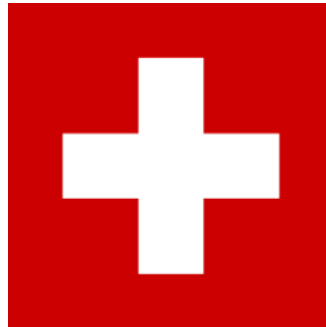

USEFUL INFORMATION & CUSTOMS REGULATIONS



Documents needed for the customs clearance of Household Goods

- Original Passport
- Original resident permit with
- Copy of renting and purchase contract
- Copy of OBL / AWB
- Copy of legible packing list. Exactly package show on OBL
- Import declaration form 18.44

Customs Regulations

- Used Household Goods and Personal Effects are duty free
- New articles (<6 months) -> dutiable, VAT

Restricted items:

Duty free, not VAT for up to 200 l of wine and for alcoholic beverages up to 18 % of volume and for alcoholic beverages of over 18 % of volume. Vehicles and boats are VAT free if vehicles/boats have been used/notified for at least one year by the owner. Arts and antiques are VAT if imported as part of the moving goods

Prohibited Articles

Weapons, drugs, medicaments, explosives, pornographic

Remarks:

- Computer, fax and telephones as part of household goods might lead to problems as those articles will be acknowledged as household goods but as dutiable office supplies.
- It is not recommended to import alcoholic drinks and food to Thailand as a special allowance will be needed.
- Antiques: It is advised to specify antiques on import documents to prove their importation in order to facilitate their exportation later. Some Asian antiques, especially religious artefacts require Fine Art dept. approval for export, whether imported by shipper or not.
