
SAFETY REGULATIONS

AIR FREIGHT

For safety reasons, the following items cannot be included in air freight shipments:

- Flammable or combustible products like nail varnish remover, petrol, paints, varnish, lubricants
- Matches, lighters, fireworks, ammunition, firearms
- Cosmetic products like perfume, nail varnish
- All types of aerosols and other pressured containers e.g. hair spray, shaving foam, deodorant, gas bottles, fire extinguishers
- Liquids
- Batteries, rechargeable batteries and magnets
- Tablet PCs and iPods, electric toothbrushes
- Toner cartridges for printers

These items will show up during the X-ray inspection at the airport and will then need to be removed from the shipment, causing considerable extra charges.

The following items are excluded from transport insurance cover and should not be included in the shipment:

- Currency, coins
- Jewelry and precious stones
- Papers and documents
- Deeds and securities



The following items may cause a problem with customs clearance and should therefore be checked before inclusion in the shipment:

- Foodstuffs including baby foods and pet food
- Alcohol
- New items
- Medicines
- Toiletries
